Rules & Regulations

1. Teams consist of two entrants.
2. Depending on the number of entrants two or three teams will run in each heat. The race is against the clock not against other teams. Even if you lose your heat you may have a faster time than other teams, so it is very important that you complete the course as fast as possible, with as few infractions as possible.
3. Each team will be timed by a Judge with a stopwatch and the time will be recorded from the GO signal, until the time the tray is placed back on the table at the Finish Line.
4. Time will be added to the Finish time for penalties in accordance with the following schedule.
 - a) Any significant amount of spillage 5 seconds
 - b) Over ½ a glass or bottle spillage additional 5 seconds
 - c) A whole glass or bottle spillage additional 10 seconds
 - d) Any breakage (glass, bottle, ashtray) additional 10 seconds
 - e) Incorrect tray at Finish Line additional 10 seconds
 - f) You may not hold on to glasses or bottles while moving
You may not hold the tray against your body to steady it
You may not put your fingers into any glass at any time.
You may not re-arrange the glasses on the center table
False Start ie: Picking up tray early
All of these items in rule (f) will result in DISQUALIFICATION
 - g) All bottles & glasses must be kept upright at all times.

All possible effort will be made to be fair and impartial but
THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL

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HOW THE LNBS ANNUAL WAITERS RACE IS RUN

TO START: each tray must contain:

Three full glasses

-Three full bottles

-One clean ashtray

At the sound of the starter's whistle, one member of the team picks up the tray and runs or walks half the course, where a bar table sits with:

-Three empty glasses

-Three empty bottles

-One dirty ash tray

The racer then exchanges what is on his/her tray with what is on the table, then moves on to the end of the course and hands the tray to his/her partner, who then completes the course by reversing the procedure, ending up at the finish line with a full tray. The race is over when the racer deposits his/her tray on the judges' table.

The **elapsed** times are then **recorded** and the judges check the trays for infractions (**as** previously noted). The **adjusted times** are then announced with the **fastest team** *advancing* to the next round. This process continues until we have the two finalists competing for the championship.
